Episcopal Greeting

Greetings All:

Ms. Aundra Lafayette, at the age of seventy-five (75) regularly appears with the Nashville Ballet as a guest performer and is invited by many local congregations to "praise dance" during their services of worship. I asked Ms. Lafayette when she is *praise dancing*, who is she and what is going through her mind? She responded, "I am a child of God who in those moments is giving back. My dance is an offering to Him, and it is intended to be a blessing to all who witness it."

Mariah Le Costa who at the age of four (4) became the darling of the Southern California Conference and Fifth Episcopal District worship gatherings in Los Angeles when without orchestration or prodding, she would leave her Mother's side in the sanctuary (the Ballroom), and find a corner in which to run and leap, to twill and dance in response to the "move of the Spirit" that she felt in that sacred space.

David, King of Ancient Israel, "danced with gladness before the Lord," as he escorted the Ark of the Covenant (the Symbol of God's presence) from the house of Obed-Edom, back to the City of David. (II Samuel 6: 14-22)

Reverend Stephanie Adams, author of *MY BODY IS THE TEMPLE*, inspired by I Corinthians 6:19, prefers *liturgical dance to praise dance*. To Reverend Adams, "*Liturgical dancing* is a prayer involving one's total being that goes up to God, is received, and then returns to bless His people."

The common thread that flows from David, the ancient King of Israel, to Mariah a child is that *true praise is spontaneous*. Not only is it spontaneous, but there are occasions when a simple nod of the head, or the raising of hands, or the recitation of "Hallelujahs and Amens" are not enough. On those occasions when the Spirit of God moves within us, touches the very ground of our being, our whole body becomes an instrument of praise. *Hence, we dance!*

When I recount all that has transpired in the world, in this nation, in the lives of so many of us since we began our sojourn together July 2016, the Seasons that we have gone through, nothing seems more appropriate than for us to spend this year in *A SEASON OF PRAISE AND THANKSGIVING*.

"Preserved by power Divine, To full salvation here, Again in Jesus praise we join, And in His sight appear. "What troubles have we seen, What conflicts have we passed, Fightings without, and fears within, Since we assembled last. "But out of all the Lord Hath brought us by His love, And still He doth our help afford, And hides our life above."

Today I give you license, if you feel like dancing, then dance!

There are some of us who can't carry a tune in a bucket, but the melody in our heart is in perfect pitch. The same grace is extended to those who have no rhythm. Irrespective of how awkward your movement may appear to onlookers, if it is your prayer, your offering of exalted praise, then who is to judge? Dance!


